### Call to Artists:

The Epsten Gallery announces a call to artists for **UrbanSuburban X: *Perception & Reflection*** (on view at Epsten Gallery September 7 – October 26, 2014) a juried exhibition in which all selected works will be for sale on a 'first come first served' basis. **Artists residing within an 80 mile radius of greater metropolitan Kansas City are eligible to apply.**

A range of art works involving ideas of Perception & Reflection of current issues, global events, and conditions of contemporary life in mediums including painting, printmaking, drawing, photography, jewelry, textiles, ceramics and functional art works will be considered. Size restrictions: Works cannot exceed 48" x 48" x 48".

Artists will have the opportunity to make a full donation of their work, or may choose to receive 50% from the sale of their work. The juror will select one work from each artist. Exceptions may apply in the case of jewelry or individual works with more than one component (i.e., diptych, etc.).

The exhibition sale will replace the standard UrbanSuburban auction this year on the 10<sup>th</sup> anniversary of this spectacular exhibition and fundraiser to support the dynamic schedule of programs at Epsten Gallery that benefits an intergenerational community of participants, exhibiting artists and arts professionals.

A full-color publication will accompany the exhibition.

Juror: Joshua Fischer, Assistant Curator, Rice Gallery at Rice University, Houston, TX

Joshua Fischer has curated installations by Andrea Dezsö, Ana Serrano, and Onishi Yasuaki. (Rice Gallery is the only university museum with a focus on site-specific installation.) He serves on the Board of Lawndale Art Center and is a regular contributor to *Turn On Art*, an interactive online discussion forum for global art; and *Glasstire*, an online magazine covering the visual arts in Texas and Southern California. Fischer graduated from Trinity University where he double majored in Studio Art and Sociology. He received an M.A. in American Studies from the University of Texas at Austin.
